

INSTRUCTIONS.

The Journal of Vessels which passed by or in the vicinity of the Lights must be kept according to the form, by noting in the proper column, at the close of each day, from the log slate, the number of the different classes of vessels which have passed during the preceding twenty-four hours.

An annual return must be made to the Inspector of the district, by filling the blanks in the printed form, which will be transmitted to him with the other returns required to be made by the regulations of the Light-house Establishment; and this book, when filled, delivered to the Supply Vessel to be turned into store.
