WONEWOC, Wis., Aug. 21.—[Special.] The weather has been most excellent for the last two weeks for the purpose of securing the grain in this section. It has been stacked in good condition, and there is considerable thrashed already. The yield is good, about twenty bushels to the acre we hear. Corn is still backward, but is likely to be a fair crop if the frosts do not take it.
