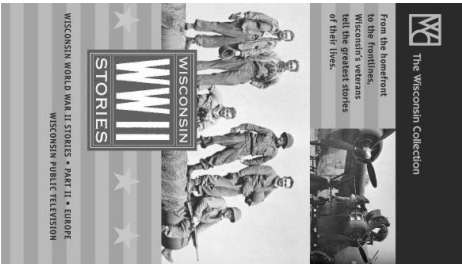


## From the home front to the frontlines, Wisconsin’s veterans tell the greatest stories of their lives.

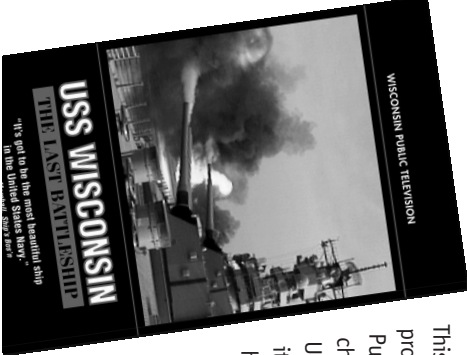

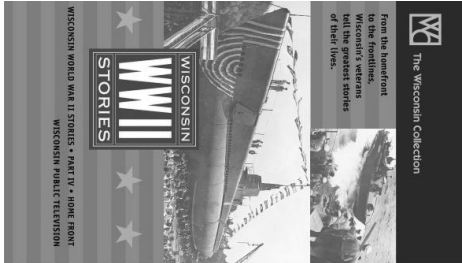
